




Candles may be pretty to look at, but they are a cause of many structure fires each year. Remember, a candle is an open flame, which means that it can easily ignite anything that can burn.

CANDLE WITH CARE

- Blow out all candles when you leave the room or go to bed. Avoid the use of candles in the bedroom and other areas where people may fall asleep.
- Keep candles at least 1 foot away from anything that can burn.



Candles and Kids

Never leave a child or pet alone in a room with a burning candle. Keep matches and lighters up high and out of children's reach in a locked cabinet.



Think about using flameless candles in your home. They look and smell like real candles.

! December is the peak month for home candle fires.




!\ More than one-third of home candle fires started in the bedroom.



Three of every five candle fires start when things that can burn are too close to the candle



If you do burn candles, make sure that you ...





- Do not touch the candle or attempt to move it until it has completely cooled and the liquid wax has hardened.
- Put candle holders on a sturdy, uncluttered surface.
- Light candles carefully. Keep your hair and any loose clothing away from the flame.
- Trim the wick. Long or crooked wicks can cause uneven burning, which can lead to wax dripping.
- Don't burn a candle all the way down. A candle in a container can safely burn to about 1/2 an inch of wax; a candle not contained should only be burned down to about 2 inches of wax.
- Never use a candle if oxygen is used in the
- Be careful if using candles during a power outage. Flashlights or other battery-powered lights are much safer than an open flame.
